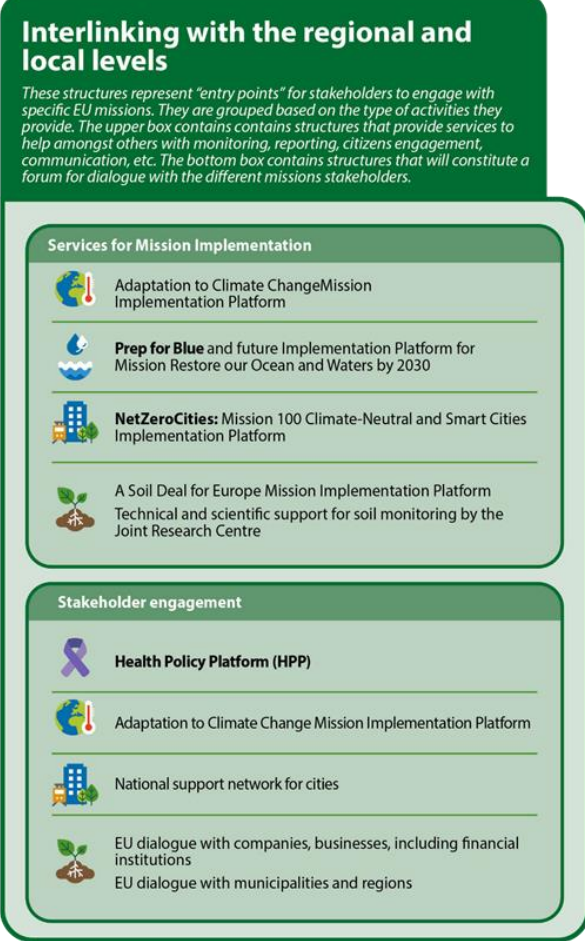
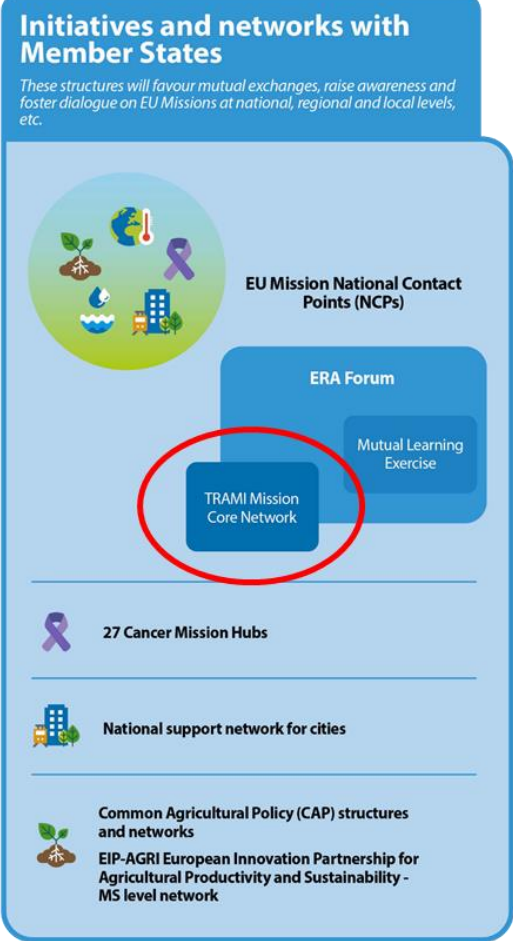
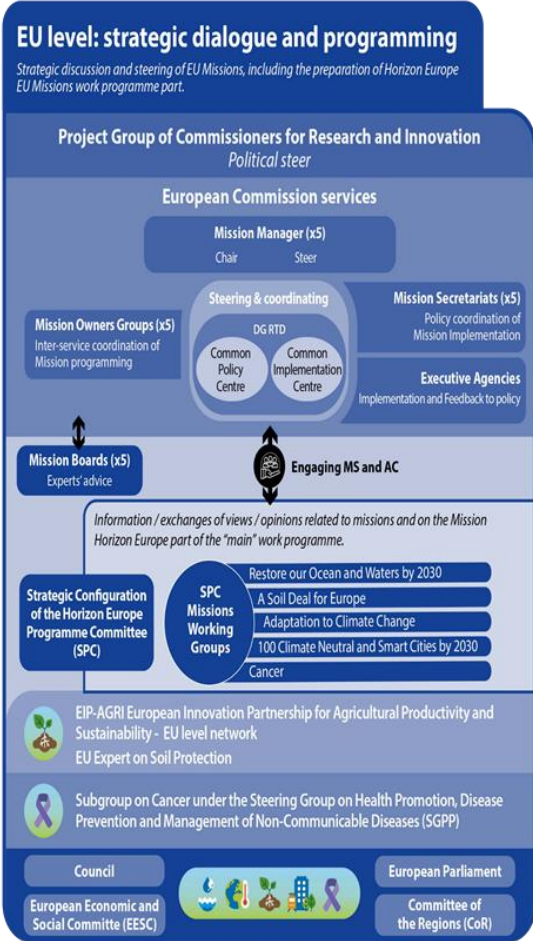


# PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Duration: 2Q2022 - 2Q2024
- Project Start: 1 April
- Project Kick-Off in Vienna: 25 – 27 April 2022

# OBJECTIVE

To foster the **cooperation and coordination** between **EU-level actions and complementary national, regional and local actions in support of the implementation of Missions**



# EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- **Shared vision** for Mission implementation at the level of MS and AC
- **Multi-level core network of engaged MS/AC** with a tailor-made governance, co-operation models, roles and responsibilities
- **Map of effective governance approaches and effective instruments** for implementation
- Mutual **learning toolbox**, knowledge exchange and mutual learning events, **co-developed use cases**
- **Knowledge platform**

- Support **coordination** between national, regional and local initiatives and **exchanging best practices**
- **Mapping** MOP (mission oriented policies) and actors and **evaluate the national governance schemes**
- Facilitate the **engagement of stakeholders** and **raise awareness** (EMiN, EMiF, other events)



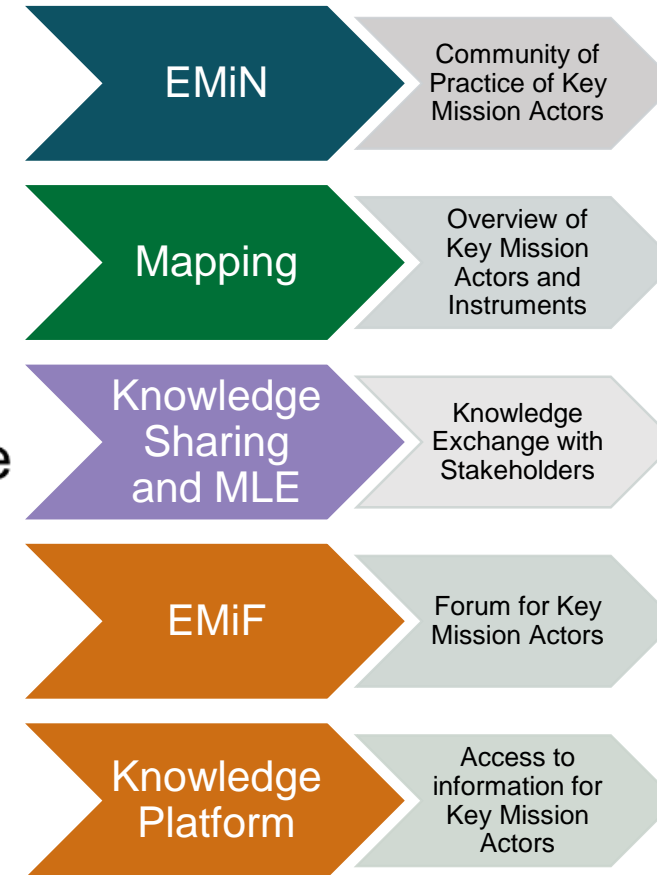

### Aims:

- Ultimately the EMiN aims to become a recognized competence hub that supports mission governors, actors and stakeholders to successfully deliver the EU-Missions' objectives

### Mapping of Mission-Oriented Policy, Initiatives and Actors



- Develop definitions, concepts and taxonomies as common intellectual underpinnings for mission-oriented policy
- Identify and capture relevant public and private actors, policy initiatives and funding streams in relation to missions
- Identify existing good practice examples for mission-oriented policy in EU member countries
- The mission data platform (online database) will be the online repository for mission-oriented policies in the context of the EU missions, including the mapping data
